RACEDAY 11
MONDAY 2ND APRIL, 2018.

RACE 1

The Stewards were without the use of the head-on camera for this race.

The Stewards noted that **#11 PRINCE ZACHARY** stumbled at the start.

Apprentice J. Reyes rider of **#4 I'MMISINGHIGHBURY** was cautioned for not riding out his mount in the straight.

RACE 2 Jockey R. Hasranah rider of **#12 RED WINE** was cautioned for not riding out his mount in the straight.

#6 WAKA WAKA weighted in at 56.5 kg. Its trainer Walter Debysingh reported that he used another trainer's saddle pad but it was defective and a piece of lead slipped out during the race. **WAKA WAKA** was disqualified from 7th place and trainer Walter Debysingh was fined **\$250.00** for a breach of **Rule 55 (10) of the Rules of Racing**.

RACE 3

The Official Veterinarian reported that **#9 PRECISE MOMENT** bled externally indicative of **E.I.P.H.** and is not to race until **16.04.2018**.

RACE 4

Jockey W. Galviz rider of **#2 MORNING DELIGHT**, unplaced, objected against **#5 PURE INNOCENCE**, unplaced, and ridden by D. Butcher for taking his ground at the top of the straight and approximately 200 metres out. After hearing the evidence of the riders' and viewing the video replay in their presence the Stewards found jockey D. Butcher guilty of careless riding and he was fined **\$150.00** for the offence. The placings were allowed to remain unaltered.

The Official Veterinarian reported that **#12 BLAZING GEM** bled externally indicative of **E.I.P.H.** and is not to race until **16.04.2018**.

RACE 5

Trainer Juan Mosca was fined **\$50.00** for the late arrival into the parade ring on **#8 STORMY FRONTIER**.

Jockey R. Ali rider of **#9 KHAL DROGO**, placed second, objected against **#8 STORMY FRONTIER**, placed fourth, ridden by apprentice D. Rodrigo and **#14 PURE PLEASURE**, placed fifth, and ridden by W. Leon for foul riding in the straight. After hearing the evidence of the riders and viewing the video replay in their presence the Stewards found that while apprentice Rodrigo's mount did drift inwards she did stop whipping. Jockey Leon stated that his saddle slipped backwards. However the Stewards observed that he continued to whip right handed causing his mount to drift inwards instead of trying to control with both hands. The Stewards found jockey Leon guilty of careless riding and fined him the sum of **\$100.00**.

The Official Veterinarian reported that **#8 STORMY FRONTIER** returned lame (Grade 4) on the left forelimb.

RACE 6

The Stewards having taken note of the performance of **#9 CRAMERS RULE** in this race and its two previous starts interviewed its trainer Harold Chadee about the issue. Mr. Chadee stated that the horse is best suited to the main track at a distance of about **1750 metres plus**.

The Stewards pointed out to him that the horse could not let itself down in the race and seemed to be not a racing proposition. He was told its future performances will be closely monitored.

RACE 7

Jockey Serrano was reported as using his phone in the Jockey's Room and when questioned stated that he had a family emergency and needed to speak with his wife. The Stewards subsequently learnt from the Jockey Room security officer that when he requested the phones from the jockeys prior to the first race he was told by Serrano that he had none.

Serrano was again interviewed in the presence of the security officer and admitted that he was untrue before. As such the Stewards fined him \$500.00 for breach of the policy regarding cell phone use in the Jockey's Room and a gross misrepresentation of facts before the Stewards.
