**NOTES FROM THE STEWARDS**  
**RACEDAY 24**  
**WEDNESDAY 1<sup>ST</sup> AUGUST, 2018.**

**RACE 1**

Apprentice T. Phillips rider of **#6 LION'S PORTION**, unplaced, objected against jockey L. Keizer rider of **#5 ROYAL BALLET**, placed second and jockey R. Hasranah, rider of **#7 WELL CONNECTED** for crossing out of the gates.

Jockey D. Blackman rider of **#3 PAINTED BUDDHA**, placed third, objected against apprentice T. Phillips rider of **#6 LION'S PORTION** and an unknown horse for crossing out of the gates.

The Stewards interviewed all the riders involved and reviewed the video replay in their presence and found that the incident was caused as a result of **#5 ROYAL BALLET** coming across the path of **LION'S PORTION** causing that runner to clip heels and the rider to lose balance and bumping **#3 PAINTED BUDDHA**.

As such the Stewards found jockey Keizer guilty of careless riding and he was fined **\$200.00** for the infringement. However the Stewards allowed the result to stand as they felt that the eventual outcome was not affected.

**RACE 2**

Apprentice T. Phillips, rider of **#4 FLEETING MOMENT**, unplaced, objected against jockey N. Samaroo, rider of **#5 LOIS LANE** for crossing out of the gates. The Stewards interviewed the riders' and reviewed the video replay in their presence. They found that the incident was accidentally caused by **LOIS LANE** jumping awkwardly to its right and after this shied to the left coming into contact with **A FLEETING MOMENT**.

The infringement was considered to be accidental and the riders cautioned to exercise more care.

**RACE 4**

Apprentice B. Pahal rider of **#7 SETTLED D'ACCOUNT**, unplaced, objected against jockey D. Butcher for foul riding at the 600 metre mark and apprentice T. Phillips rider of **#2 MESSI**, unplaced, objected against **#13 THE KING'S GIFT**, also unplaced, ridden by J. Arneaud for foul riding at the **600** metre mark. After hearing the evidence of the riders and viewing the video replay in their presence the Stewards found that jockey Arneaud allowed his mount to drift inward taking the ground of **#2 MESSI**, which had to be checked at that stage which resulted in **MESSI** veering to the right onto **#8 REDHOTFILLYPEPPER**, which in turn bumped into **SETTLED D'ACCOUNT**.

The Stewards found jockey J. Arneaud guilty of careless riding and he was fined the sum of **\$100.00**.

Jockey J. Bracho rider of **#14 MONEY MATTERS** was fined **\$350.00** for excessive use of the whip.

**RACE 5**

The Stewards interviewed trainer B. P. Nurse in connection with the running of his charge **JUST SAY YES**, and more specifically their observations that the animal was unable to get into a brisk canter during the race. He stated that the horse is an enigma as it worked upsides last week winner **GOLAZO** and it was a surprising run to him.

Apprentice D. Rodrigo the rider of **#1 JUST SAY YES** stated that the horse refused to come out of that gait during the race.

These explanations were noted.

The Official Veterinarian reported that **#10 SPECIAL MOMENTS** returned lame on the right fore (Grade 3.)

The Stewards noted that **#10 WHY KAPALUA** dwelt and reared at the off.

**RACE 8**

The Stewards noted that **#5 USAIN** fly jumped on leaving the gates.

**RACE 9**

Trainer Richard Stephen was fined **\$50.00** for incorrect colours on **#8 RED CLOUD**.

Jockey J. Arneaud rider of **#2 DUBLIN FASHION**, placed third, objected against jockey K. Khelawan rider of **#3 SHANGRI LA**, unplaced, for taking his ground at the 400 metre mark and jockey L. Keizer rider of **#9 CACTUS TREASURE**, unplaced, objected to an unidentified horse for taking his ground at the 400 metre mark.

After hearing the evidence of the riders involved and viewing the video replay in their presence the Stewards found that both incidents were caused as a result of jockey Khelawan angling his horse outward into the path of both **DUBLIN FASHION** and **CACTUS TREASURE** causing both to check.

Jockey K. Khelawan was fined **\$150.00** for careless riding.
