**RACE 1**

The Stewards were without the head-on home-straight camera for this race.

The Stewards noted that **#6 WYATT EARP** jumped to the right leaving the gates.

**RACE 2**

The Official Veterinarian reported that **#2 GALAXY** bled externally indicative of **E.I.P.H.** and is not to race until **22.02.2019.**

**RACE 3**

The Starter reported that **#2 SORAYAH** refused under orders.

Glenn Mohammed was advised that this was the second consecutive occasion of this occurrence and if it happened again in its next start the horse would be banned.

**RACE 4**

The Stewards received a report from the clerk of the scales that apprentice B. Pahal hit jockey Y. Serrano with his skull cap to the right side of his face in the weighing room while he was on the scale. The Stewards interviewed both riders and also Mr. Venice Richards and trainer Harriram Gobin. Both witnesses confirmed the incident and trainer Gobin also stated that he was threatened by apprentice B. Pahal.

Apprentice Pahal in his defence stated that the horses were racing tight around the turn and Serrano struck him with the whip. In viewing the video replay the accusation could not be confirmed.

The Stewards after considering all the evidence suspended apprentice Pahal for the next five (5) days of Racing for behaviour unbecoming of a professional rider and in breach of **Rule 69 (2) and (3) of the Rules of Racing.**

The Stewards further recommend that apprentice Pahal be referred to the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority for counseling to address his anger issues.

The Official Veterinarian reported that **#2 THE KING'S GIFT** was lame on the left front (Grade2).
